Dear Patient

Our practice will be re-opening on 8 June 2020.

The treatments you are offered may be different to those you received before, depending on staff and equipment available.

Priority will be given initially to patients who are in pain, or who were in the middle of treatment when the practice closed.

It will take some time before services return to what you previously experienced as normal. Please be patient.

Infection control has always been a top priority for our practice and you may have seen this during your visits to our surgery. Our practice follows infection control guidelines made by the governing bodies.

We are up-to-date on new guidance that has been issued, and would be happy to discuss this with you during the assessment call.

You may see some changes when it is time for your next appointment. We have made these changes to help protect our patients and staff.

For example:

- Our practice will communicate with you beforehand to ask some screening questions. You'll be asked those same questions again at your appointment
- We have hand sanitiser that we will ask you to use when you enter the practice.
- We no longer offer magazines, children's toys etc since those items are difficult to clean and disinfect
- Appointments will be managed to allow for social distancing between patients. That might mean that you're offered fewer options for scheduling your appointment.
- We will be wearing different PPE to previously, and will have that equipment on when you come in to the surgery. We know this doesn't look very friendly, but would ask for your understanding.

- Please do not arrive without an appointment
- Please do not arrive early to the practice.
- If you arrive early please wait outside the practice
- Please come wearing a mask if possible or be prepared to wear one.
- With the exception of children and patients with carers, patients should come alone
- A distance of at least 2 metres must be observed if another patient is present in the dental practice
- Staff will not shake your hand
- Payment should be made by card where possible
- If you show symptoms following appointment booking, you should contact the practice by phone
